Description

The project consists of the construction and operation of a new airport and adjacent facilities in Mexico City. The objective is to replace the current airport which is currently operating above capacity. It will be located on land which used to contain the TexcocLake, in the municipalities of Texcoco and Atenco. The project seeks to be the first airport in the world with a Platinum LEED certification and the first outside of Europe to have a neutral carbon footprint.
